

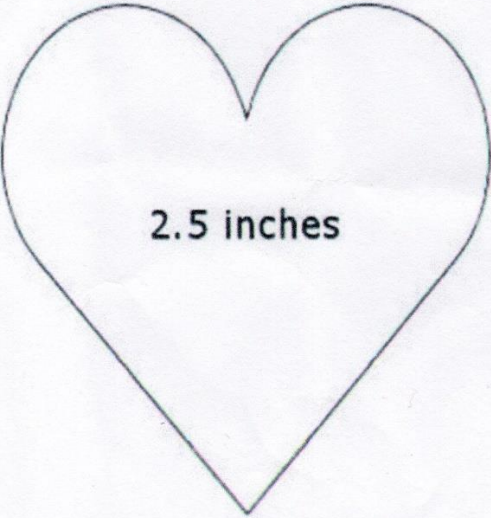
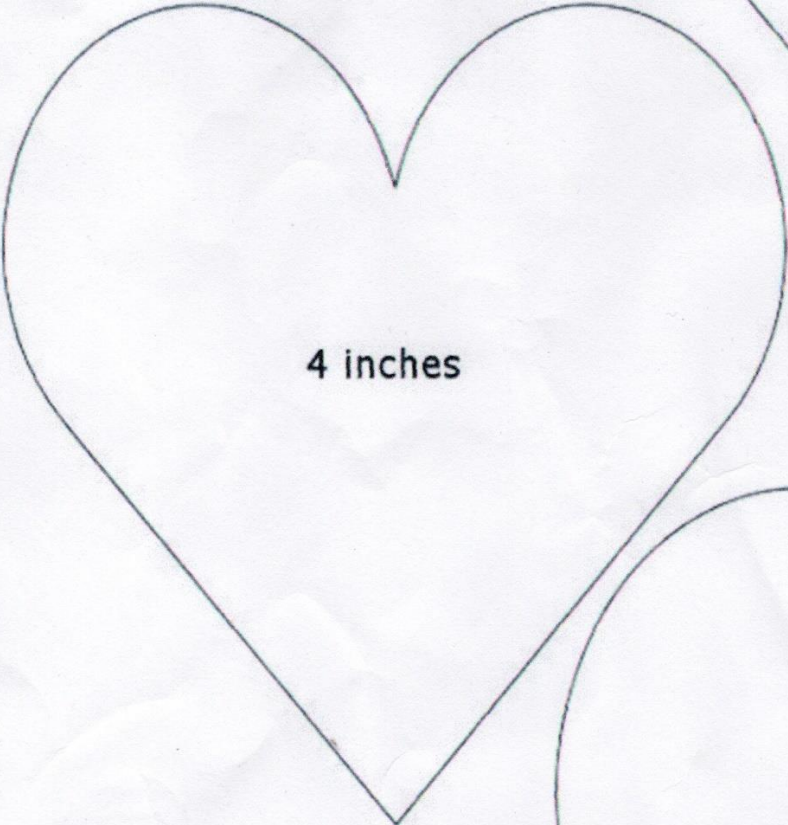
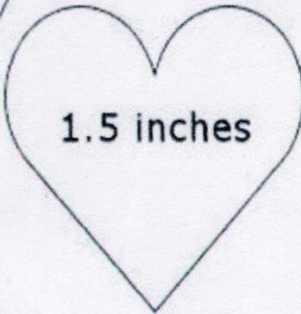
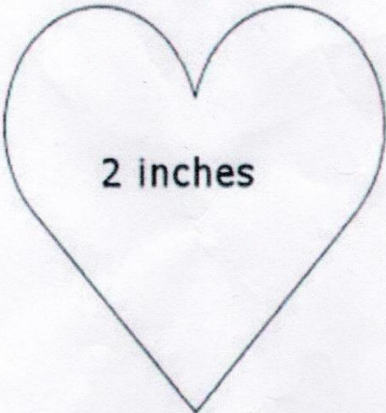
## February Block A

This is an applique block for you to enjoy.

Cut background fabric 10 ½ X 10 ½ inch square. Fold in half both directions and mark.

The center four hearts are all two inches. I placed them point in around the center about ¼ inch apart. The hearts surrounding them are 1 ½ inches. There are 8 of them. 4 are placed between the first set and 4 above the first set. The 4 lighter ones are the back side of the fabrics. Yes, I put the adhesive on the wrong side 😊

If you are making turned edge applique, cut your hearts at 2 ½ and 2 inches.





## FEBRUARY Block B

10 X10 inch finished

This is a paper pieced block. Using your favorite paper piecing style, start with number 1. Be sure your fabric covers the entire area for that piece with at least  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch over the lines to be sewn.
