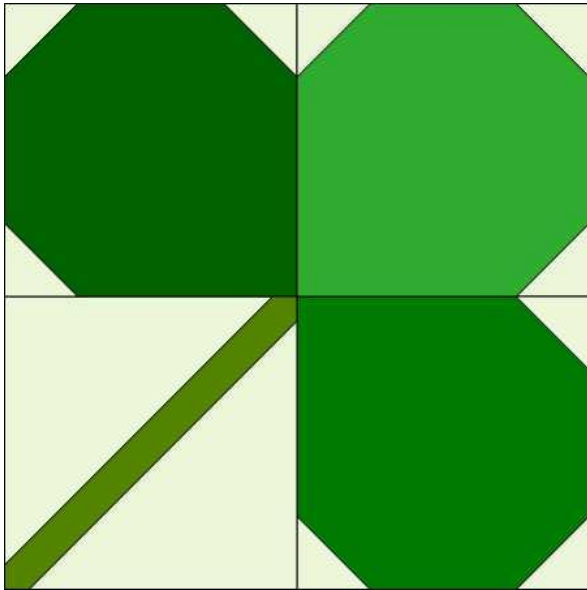


MARCH BLOCK OF THE MONTH



SHAMROCK

10 inch finished block. All seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ inch.

Color A – 1 ea. $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch block.

1 ea. 1 X 6 inch strip.

Color B – 2 ea. $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch blocks.

Color C – 1 ea. $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch block. Background. Cut diagonally.

9 each 2 inch blocks.

For each $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch shamrock leaf, place one square color C 2 inch blocks on 3 corners of color A and color B. Sew diagonally and trim off excess.

Take both $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch triangles, color C and sew to 1 X 6 inch piece, color A. Keep in mind that you will be making a square.

Trim all finished squares to $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

Place the 3 leaf squares with plain corners together. The stem square needs to be placed with the stem pointed towards the center of the block. Sew the 4 squares together. A shamrock has been born!

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
